The story so far: India is divided into Red, Orange and Green districts depending on the quantum of, or the absence of, Covid-19 cases recorded in the district. While the Red districts face several debilitating curbs on the conduct of business, the Orange and Green districts are able to get back to less restrictive environments after the nationwide lockdown that ended on May 3, 2020.

A statewise division of districts into Red, Orange and Green is given alongside.

An epiphany led to the creation of this report: Can the Green and Orange districts, lead the recovery of Indian Business?

The difference in the perspectives of the optimists and the ‘others’ has never been so stark. This is an optimists report. For the ‘others’, this is an ‘opportunists’ report – since dark words are often more fashionable.

Can the green and orange districts contribute to the economy more than before the virus cataclysm? Is this an opportunity for these areas to step up and be counted?

As this discussion deepened, we looked at the data to see what were the resources – human and natural – available to the green and orange districts. The story that these numbers create is interesting, to say the least.

To be fair, the story is double edged. While it points to the depth of the economic strength of the country, it also points to the vast urban aggregations that are the hubs of our current economic structure, and also the hubs of the pandemic.


As of **May 8, 2020**, the data reads like this:

Some observations from this table:


81% of the districts (600 in total) are in the **Orange** and **Green** categories, and should therefore be able to quickly reach their pre-Covid19 GDP per capita

There are 115 Green districts with populations >10 lakhs


23 crores: The combined population of districts with more than 10 lakh population each


There are 244 Orange districts with populations >10 lakhs
